What is our posture in order to hear?


- Be open to God speaking through familiar passages afresh

- Grow in desire for, delight of, and joy in, the Word



(v1-2) In the <u>beginning</u> the Word already existed.

The Word was with God, and the Word was God. He existed in the <u>beginning</u> with God.

(v3-4) God created everything through him, and nothing was created except through him. The Word gave life to everything that was created, and his life brought light to everyone.

Chapter 1

The Son is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation. For in him all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities; all things have been created through him and for him. He is before all things, and in him all things hold together.

And he is the head of the body, the church; he is the beginning and the firstborn from among the dead, so that in everything he might have the supremacy. For God was pleased to have all his fullness dwell in him, and through him to reconcile to himself all things, whether things on earth or things in heaven, by making peace through his blood, shed on the cross. (Col 1:15-20)

Tabernacle, God's dwelling place with His people:
Temporary; Humble; outwardly unattractive
Centre of the Camp
Place the law was preserved
Place of sacrifice, where priests were fed & place of worship
