Why did Nicodemus seek out Jesus?

Under Roman authority in the time of Christ, the Sanhedrin was the final court of appeals for matters regarding Jewish law and religion. The Sanhedrin had responsibility to find out about any teachers or other public figures who might lead the people astray!


"Now this was John's testimony when the Jewish leaders in Jerusalem sent priests and Levites to ask him who he was" (John 1:19)


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

Living in the truth, living in the light

This is the verdict:

Light has come into the world, but people loved darkness instead of light because their deeds were evil. Everyone who does evil hates the light, and will not come into the light for fear that their deeds will be exposed.

But whoever lives by the truth comes into the light; so that it may be seen plainly that what they have done has been done in the sight of God. (John 3:19-21)

The two questions Nicodemos was asking: 1/The possibility of the new birth; 2/and the process of the new birth.

Born again, born anew, new birth – "to enter the kingdom" imperative: exclusive nature – 'new' this 'new' divides eternal and condemned life

Living in the truth, living in the light

Flesh gives birth to flesh, but the Spirit gives birth to spirit. You should not be surprised at my saying, 'You must be born again.'

(John 3:6-7)

Genesis-esc feel about 'born again' – "according to its kind"






Jesus uses plural verbs four times implying that:
we is "Jesus and the prophets" (Jn3:11)


Nicodemus should have known about this "regeneration"






lives by / belief is a "participation," not just acknowledgement.
